About Dress Designing course

This course helps the student to develop core fundamental skills such as the basics of how to draft a pattern, applying styles, develop the skills needed to execute a garment, to improve persons and practical responsibility and to identify the concepts of fashion. Course includes practical's sessions and practical training in sewing and pattern drafting. House makers, part time workers and fashion enthusiast can make use of this course. After this course you can find various jobs as a fashion co-coordinator, Fashion Designer or become an Entrepreneur running your own boutique or fashion store. Dress Designing is a 6 months certificate course with 2 batches every year at Chavara Cultural Centre (Head Office). This course has 2 time slots. Morning and afternoon. Classes for the morning batch commences from 10 am - 1 pm and classes for the afternoon batch commences from 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM. The classes are held 5 days a week, i.e. Monday to Friday.

Dress Designing certificate course Covers

1- Pattern Making

Pattern is the template form which the part of a garment are traced onto fabric before being cut out and assembled.

2- Surface Ornamentation

Student learns various techniques such as designer stitches, embroideries for surface enrichments which emphasize the garment.

3- Clothing Construction

Clothing Construction is the final process before completing the garment by adding's buttons, sequins, bead work and hand stitches.

Syllabus/ Complete Course Details

This Certificate course is the subset of the 1 year fashion designing diploma course which includes 8 subjects whereas dress designing course includes only 3 subjects. The duration of the course may exceed 6 months depending on the practical sessions being carried out. There are only limited numbers of seats for this course.

* Basic embroidery stitches (50 Numbers) * Mirror work * Traditional handwork of different states of India * Ribbon work * Different methods of fabric painting * Traditional Embroidery * Wariy Painting * Metal Embroidery * Tie & dye *
